

- Score of 525 or more on TOEFL test (to study in English)
- Fluency in Spanish (to study in the Hispanic Media Broadcasting Program)
- \$125.00 USD non-refundable application fee
- Successful completion of vocal audition to be conducted by school personnel via telephone or Skype
- Documentation proving student has financial resources to pay tuition, housing, food, transportation, and health insurance costs
